'THE PHILADELPHIA VOICE CLINIC APPROACH TO THE MANAGEMENT OF PROFESSIONAL VOICE USERS'

This is a unique collaboration between the **British Voice Association** and the **London Voice Clinical Excellence Network**.

This clinically based weekend event runs on **Saturday 2nd February 2019, 12.30pm - 5.45pm** and **Sunday 3rd February 2019, 9.15am - 5pm** at **St. Thomas' Hospital, London**.

We are delighted to be hosting **Professor Robert Sataloff**, Consultant ENT Surgeon, **Margaret Baroody**, Singing Voice Specialist and **Bridget Rose**, Speech and Language Therapist for this clinically focussed event. Professor Sataloff is internationally recognised as one of the founders of the field of voice and his team are highly experienced in working with a range of high level professional voice users. This will be the first time that the team has travelled together across the Atlantic to speak as a team.

The Saturday afternoon event will explore the collaborative work between the SLT and SVS including rehabilitation protocols, skill and competency development and training. This will be highly relevant for SLTs, singing teachers, physiotherapists, osteopaths and students working in the field of voice rehabilitation.

The Sunday event will continue with the multi-disciplinary focus in the management of difficult cases, which may also involve the ENT surgeon. Panel discussions will also involve UK laryngologists including **Mr John Rubin**, **Mr Meredydd Harries**, **Mr Nicholas Gibbins**, **Mr Declan Costello** and **Mr Nimesh Patel**. The day is relevant for all those involved in vocal rehabilitation of the spoken and singing voice. Surgical management of complex cases such as management of vocal fold scar and large benign vocal fold lesions will be incorporated.

We are also making a call for submission of audit or research projects in the field.

There will be a conference dinner at 8pm on Saturday 2nd February.
