## About the programme:

This will be the first of its kind, a unique surgical masterclass course focusing on all aspects of laryngectomy and laryngopharyngectomy and voice restoration delivering high-quality, evidence based training and education.

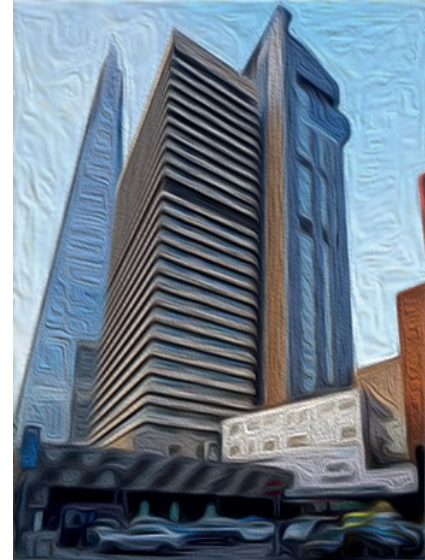
The course includes lectures covering all aspects of laryngectomy surgery along with the dilemmas on management of the thyroid, the salvage patient, the reconstruction and the voice restoration. Cadaveric sessions will allow delegates to perform laryngectomy, neck dissection, primary and secondary puncture.

This is a 3-year rolling program aiming to enhance the surgical and management set skills of senior ENT trainees, Head and Neck Fellows and newly appointed Head and Neck Consultants. Year 2 will focus on partial laryngectomy and year 3, endoscopic transoral techniques.

- ENT surgical trainees who have a specialist interest in Head and Neck surgery and are within 24 months of their CCT (certificate of completion of training).
- National and international post CCT Head and Neck surgical fellows
- Head and Neck Consultant surgeons within 2 years of appointment
